Overview The collection contain various letters, receipts, legal papers, and club booklets, as well as a 19th century poll list, a single copy of meeting minutes for St. Jude's Church (Walterboro) from 1893 and more.

Notes About the Collection

The collection is divided into two subsets - Collection A and Collection B.

Collection A contains miscellaneous papers that were originally donated by an unknown donor on an unknown date to the Colleton Museum who catalogued the collection in their "FIS - Found in Storage" collection. At some point the collection was transferred to the Colleton County Memorial Library. The original accession papers from the Colleton Museum have been retained with Collection A. The collection heavily references an SL Paul, John Lucas and William Robinson.

Collection B was donated by an unknown donor on an unknown date to the Colleton County Memorial Library where it was originally housed in the library's Vertical File, before being transferred to the archives in 2022. Several items in the collection reference an RA Willis.
